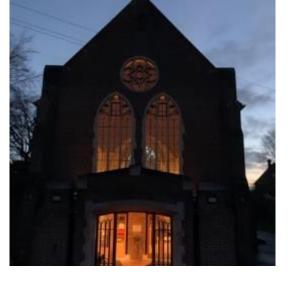

A Mission Action Plan (MAP) is a strategic process and document used by churches and organizations to outline their goals, vision for the future, and practical steps to achieve those goals. It helps to ensure that activities are aligned with the organization's mission and values, and that resources are stewarded effectively

St John's MAP Goals

To build up the Community life of St John's

1. Create a volunteer Database and amend Parish Administrator contract to create and maintain Database. This will be done for the appointment of the next Parish Administrator (2023)

2. In the next 12 months to set up a Hospitality Team with the aim of organising events through the year for all ages, both for the congregation and wider community.

3. In the next 2 years to set up termly connection groups for shared interested amongst the congregation, such as golf or gardening.

Stewardship and Giving

1. This year to set up a Giving Committee to focus on our giving as a church.

2. In the next 12 months to run a Giving Campaign at St John's, to include teaching on Giving as well

3. In the next 2 years to set up a Friends of St Johns.

Children and Young People

1. This year gather together all those who work with children and young people to plan a vision for this area of parish life.

2. In the next 12 months start a youth club for young people in the Parish

3. In the next 2 years explore how we resource ministry to families and young people

Welcome and Invitation

1. This year, annually preach on welcome and inclusivity

2. In the next 12 months hold welcomer training for all those involved

3. In the next 2 years create a welcome leaflet for new members to church

Deepening Discipleship

Three year cycle:

Theme of learning: hold a study course, parish weekend away, organising extra learning events.

Theme of pilgrimage: hold a Parish Pilgrimage (one day), teaching throughout the year on this theme.

Theme of a Retreat: hold a retreat at home; teaching throughout the year

- Between 2023 and 2024 5 people left the giving scheme this is people who have moved away or have died
- Already in 2025 we have lost 5 people from the giving scheme (£4k loss of income for 2025)
- As at the end of 2024 no-one new had joined the pledged giving scheme since December 2023
- Most people who give by Standing Order don't increase their giving each year.
- People giving through PGS are more likely to increase each year

How you can help

- If you currently give by standing order please consider investing a small amount of time in moving your giving to PGS (Parish Giving Scheme)
- If you give by standing order and haven't increased your giving recently is this something that you could consider doing now?
- If you come fairly regularly and give either in cash or using the contactless device could you consider making this a regular donation through PGS?

Challenges for 2025

- Ensuring all who regularly worship at St John's are encouraged to join the pledged giving scheme
- Loss of income from Fusion from September
- Capital expenditure
